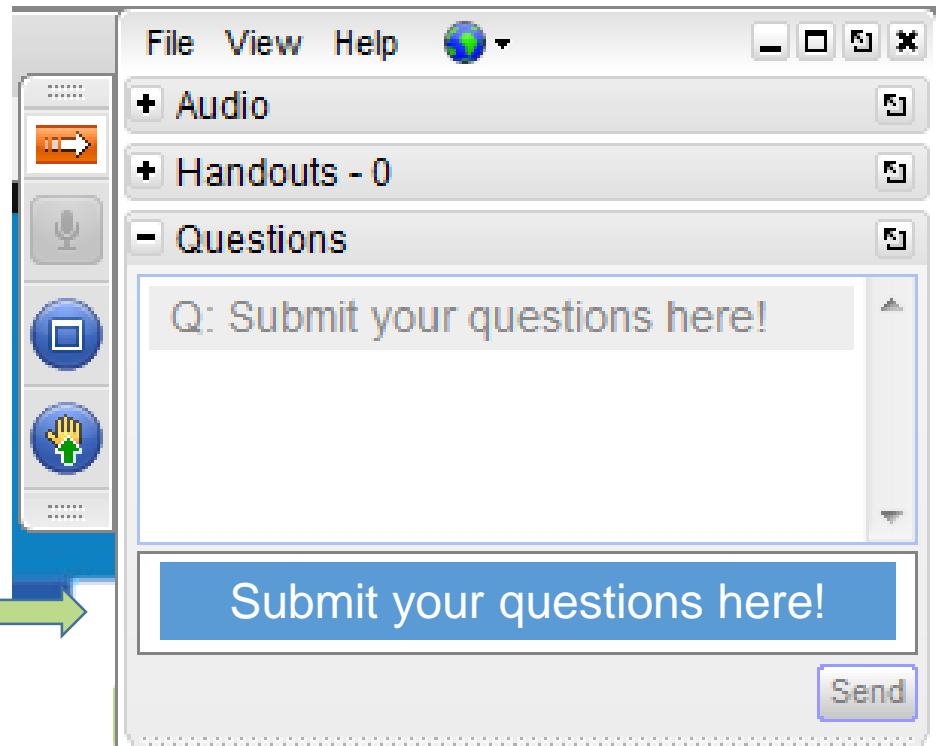

1. Support a movement acknowledging the social determinants of health



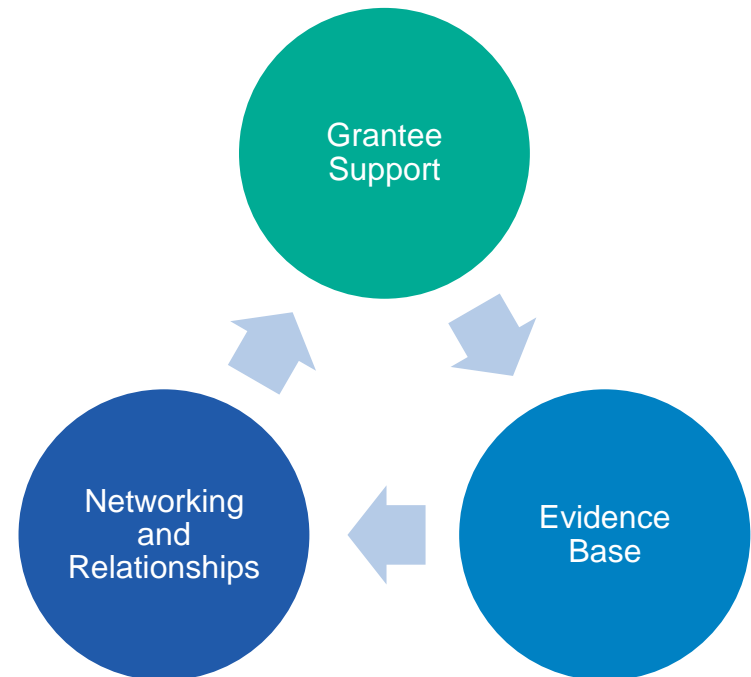
2. Build an evidence base for the field of multi-sector data integration to improve health

DASH Focus

1. Work with grantees and partners to test, implement, and document innovative practices
2. Build and disseminate successful practices and evidence base for the field
3. Cultivate relationships among experts to co-create a national movement to support local initiatives



DASH Mentor Program: Purpose and Activities

Purpose: To recognize high achievement in multi-sector data sharing and amplify and replicate successful local efforts

Potential Activities

- Create and disseminate specific tools/products/resources
- Enable ongoing documentation, learning, and dissemination about pitfalls, best practices, and the mechanisms of success
- Enable and encourage the continued participation by mature collaborations in All In
- Transfer skills and knowledge directly to communities with less experience developing data systems
- Test and document collaborative data sharing efforts

DASH Mentor Program: Award Details

- Maximum award = \$50,000 (50% awarded to mentor and 50% awarded to mentees)
- One year project duration

DASH Mentor Program: Eligibility Criteria

- A member of All In
 - Current and former grantees of All In partners (DASH, CHP, CO Health Foundation, BUILD, PHNCI, PHIL, NJHI)
 - Leaders from local collaborations that are not funded by an All In partner but have been active in the learning network
- Extensive, documented, and ongoing experience with multi-sector data sharing
- Registered and participating in the All In online community (allin.healthdoers.org)

DASH Mentor Program Activities

- Co-lead the cohort group on the All In online community
- Host a site visit for cohort members
- Lead a workshop in conjunction with a national or regional meeting
- Provide consultation to interested All In members
- Propose a set of evaluative measures to determine the value of this mentorship structure
- Others to be identified by RWJF and NPO staff and external stakeholders

Topical Areas for Mentor Award Focus

- Community health assessment
- Coordinated whole-person care
- Policy, systems, or environmental change
- Linking health care and social needs
- Working with other data sources or data sharing mechanisms
- Aligning stakeholders from different sectors
- Planning for data sharing (governance, consent, vendor selection, identity matching, workflow, etc.)
- Other topics in line with this award program to be considered
